## **GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Work in a team approach with high school youth in an afterschool program located at Overfelt and/or Yerba Buena High schools to support youth with life skills, academics, and social programming. This includes but is NOT LIMITED TO the following:

- Provide life skills coaching to program participants and work with youth to develop three goals during program length
- Participate in pro-social after school activities
- Provide after-school homework assistance
- Enroll youth into program and collect documentation, insure confidentiality for all youth
- Ensure youth are in the classroom or permitted areas, and are following program rules
- Encourage youth to participate in all program activities
- Maintain the cleanliness of classroom and surroundings area
- Model positive & appropriate language and behavior
- Maintain inventory of supplies needed
- Ensure computers, AC, doors are locked/off prior to leaving for the day
- Provide admin support for community meetings
- May organize and coordinate workshops that deal with issues pertinent to program participants
- Other duties as assigned.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High school graduate or higher education.
- Experience working with a culturally diverse, youth population.
- Valid CA Driver's License, car, insurance, and the ability to transport students
- Bi-lingual, bi-cultural Spanish required
- Right to work in the United States.
